



Southeast Furniture RFP Q &A:

Q: I'm interested in bidding the project, but may not have a designer available to quote it by the deadline. I assume this is a hard date and we cannot request an extension?

A: You are correct, this is a hard date and we cannot do an extension. I understand if you are unable to bid but keep in mind you can always bid on our future projects which we have a few coming up.

Q: Is the delivery date for Phase I flexible?

Most manufacturer's standard lead times range from 4-6 weeks. If the bids will be opened the week May 6th and the first phase of delivery is expected on June 10th, that is only 5 weeks.

A: No, the delivery date for Phase I is not flexible. We expect to install the furniture June 10th. However, if a manufacturer knows they cannot meet the deadline and will be late a few days then we would like to be notified as soon as possible so we can decide if we accept.

Q: Per Section C. Contract Specification, I am reaching out to you as the Project Director to see if you will accept a substitute for the Friant Furniture that is equal to or better than the Friant in the spec?

A: Yes, we will accept a substitute for Friant Furniture that is equal to or better than the Friant in the spec.

Q: If we are unable to provide a substitute for the Friant furniture will you accept and review a partial proposal for consideration?

A: Yes, we accept partial proposals and although a complete proposal is submitted we have the right to award separate items per proposal.
